

Car Disposal Guidelines



Smart Environmental in conjunction with Sims Pacific Metals have a code of safe practice for accepting vehicle scrap.

Please use the following guidelines to ensure your vehicle is ready for disposal.

Sims Pacific Metals require that vehicles are prepared in the following way;

- All fluids are drained from differentials, engines, radiators and fuel tanks, window wiper reservoirs.
- The fuel tank is punctured in at least two places or removed

Sims Pacific Metals require that the following items are removed from vehicles prior to disposal;

- LPG, oxygen, acetylene or any other compressed gas cylinders
- Any sealed units including any aerosol cans
- Any chemicals, hazardous or flammable
- Any radioactive material
- Batteries (These can be recycled for free at the Transfer Station)
- All rubbish and loose items
- All tyres, rims can be left on
- Any timber and agricultural products
- Any refrigerator compressors and air-conditioning units that have not been de-gassed and certified.

All vehicles will be inspected on arrival, if the conditions above have not been met, we will not accept the car body for disposal.
