

What can go into the recycling wheelie bin?

YES ✓

- Newspapers, magazines, junk mail and brochures
- Cardboard and non-foil wrapping paper
- Dry food packaging e.g. cereal boxes
- Telephone directories
- Writing paper and envelopes
- Empty pizza boxes (free of any food remnants)
- Tetra Pak cartons and liquid paperboard containers
- Plastic milk and soft drink bottles - rinsed
- Plastic shampoo and conditioner bottles - rinsed
- Plastic household cleaning bottles - rinsed
- Milk and juice cartons - rinsed
- Yoghurt pots, margarine tubs, ice cream containers - washed
- Drink cans - aluminum and steel - rinsed
- Food tins - rinsed
- Empty aerosols
- Any plastic container marked with any of the recycling symbols



NO ✗

- Household rubbish
- Plastic Shopping bags and plastic food wrap
- Plastic laundry containers
- Hot ashes
- Ceramics, crockery, porcelain and oven ware
- Computers
- Food waste
- Engine oil bottles and automotive parts
- Paints and chemicals
- Garden waste
- Disposable nappies
- Clothing and fabric

What can go into the recycling crate?

YES ✓

- Glass bottles and jars - rinsed with tops/lids removed

NO ✗

- Drinking glasses
- Mirrors
- Light bulbs
- Window or windscreen glass
