RULES AND CONDITIONS

The submitted design to be the designer's symbolic perspective of what Buller means or represents to them. Design medium to be digital art, submitted as a JPEG file on the template provided. This means that art can either be drawn directly onto the template then scanned or can be designed with graphics software and saved as a JPEG or PDF.

Designs should be created to match the template shape, provided digitally to applicants.

The designer's name and contact details must accompany the design submitted.

Every person may submit one design only.

Deadline for design submissions is **Friday 20 October 2017**.

Three finalists will be chosen by the judging panel by Wednesday 25 October 2017.

Judges' decisions are final.

The three winning designs will be created into flags through Buller District Council.

Cash awards for the three winning entrants and their flags will be displayed along Palmerston Street.

DESIGN CRITERIA

No letters or numbers – the design must work if reversed

Relevance to the Buller District

Strength of visual design

Strength of concept

Strength of design

Use of colour

Relevance as a flag, unfurled or furled

JUDGING

Judging panel comprised of: an artist, a designer, a council representative, an iwi representative and a community represent will review the designs and determine the three best designs.

Judges will use pre-determined criteria to guide them.
