- The Medical Officer of Health has raised no matters in opposition to this application.
- The application was not required to be publicly notified.
- The applicant has demonstrated that the manner in which they sell, supply, display and promote alcohol complies with the Act.

Free potable drinking water must be available on the premises for the duration of the licence.

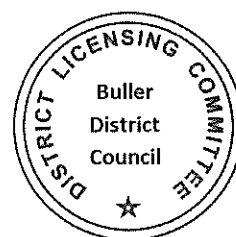
- (b) Alcohol may be sold in the following types of containers only: Glassware.
- (c) The following steps must be taken to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol:
- (i) Food must be available at reasonable prices for consumption for the duration of the event.
  - (ii) The licensee must have available for consumption, at all times when alcohol is being sold or supplied, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low alcohol refreshments.
  - (iii) Transport options signage must be displayed. A phone must also be available on site to contact an alternative form of transport if required. A courtesy vehicle is also available.
- (d) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
- (i) ID is to be requested from any person who looks under 25 years of age.
  - (ii) There must be no sale or supply of alcohol to minors or intoxicated persons and there must be displayed at every point-of-sale appropriate signs detailing these restrictions.
  - (iii) Any intoxicated persons may not enter or remain on the premises.
- (e) A copy of the licence and conditions must be displayed in a prominent place so as to be easily read by persons entering through the principal entrances.
- (f) The following parts of the premises are designated as:  
**Undesignated:** Whole premises.
- (g) The managers appointed for the purpose of this licence are to be Glenda Dawson and Lexie Davis. A sign must be displayed identifying the duty manager.
