Hughes Place – Flap Gate – Not yet upgraded
Rintoul Street – Upgraded to WaStop, is also the Wastewater overflow
Brougham Street – Flap Gate – Not yet upgraded
Henley Street – Upgraded to WaStop
Pakington Street – Flap Gate – Not yet upgraded
Cobden Street – Flap Gate – Not yet upgraded
