 2 (Pulse Energy Recreation Centre Westport & Reefton Swimming Pool Reefton)
 Reefton Swimming Pool is a seasonal pool. This facility operates for 26 weeks in the year.
- What is the maximum number of swimmers allowed in at a time, at each facility?
 100 swimmers.
- How many days was each facility closed this year, outside normal days they are shut, up to September 30th?

Pulse Energy Recreation Centre – Westport – Closed <u>O days</u> outside normal days it is shut.

Reefton Swimming Pool – Reefton – Closed <u>1 day</u> outside normal days it is shut.

- How many days was each facility partially closed this year, up to September 30th?
 Zero partial closures for both facilities.
- How many people used the pool facilities this year to September 30th, on average, per day?

Pulse Energy Recreation Centre – Westport – 135 people on average per day

Reefton Swimming Pool – Reefton – 20 people on average per day

What was the reason for the closures and partial closures?
 Reefton Pool Staff isolating with covid so we were unable to staff that pool for one

day.

• How many days was each facility closed last year (2022), outside normal days they are shut, for the full calendar year?

Pulse Energy Recreation Centre – Westport – Closed <u>6 days</u> outside normal days it is shut.

Reefton Swimming Pool – Reefton – Closed 1 day outside normal days it is shut.

How many days was each facility partially closed, in 2022?

Pulse Energy Recreation Centre – Westport – 0 days partially closed.

Reefton Swimming Pool – Reefton – partially closed 9 days end of March

How many people used the pool facilities in 2022 on average, per day?

Pulse Energy Recreation Centre – Westport – 118 people on average per day Reefton Swimming Pool – Reefton – 15 people on average per day

• What was the reason for the closures and partial closures?

Pulse Energy Recreation Centre – Westport

3 days closed in February due to the floods 3rd feb – 5th feb

3 days closed for planned facility maintenance

We were partially closed over 5 days in late March/early April due to staff shortages – we had multiple staff isolating with covid. We closed 2-3hrs early on some of those days or opened 2-3hrs later.

Reefton Swimming Pool – Reefton

29th Jan – Staff Illness – Covid – Staff shortage

March 3rd – 8th – unforeseen filtration issue

End of March – partial closures across 9 days due to Staff illness – Covid – Staff shortage

2 days closed due to Staff Illness - Covid - Staff shortage

• How many days was each facility closed last year (2021), outside normal days they are shut, for the full calendar year?

Pulse Energy Recreation Centre – Westport – Closed 29 days outside normal days it is shut.

How many days was each facility partially closed, in 2021?

Pulse Energy Recreation Centre – Westport – 5 March – planned maintenance. Closed for 4hrs

Reefton Swimming Pool – Reefton – Partially closed one day for unplanned maintenance

How many people used the pool facilities in 2021 on average, per day?

Pulse Energy Recreation Centre – Westport – 128 people on average per day

Reefton Swimming Pool – Reefton – 18 people on average per day

What was the reason for the closures and partial closures?

Pulse Energy Recreation Centre - Westport

5th March – Partial closure for maintenance 3rd – 9th May – Planned Maintenance – floors and filters 18th July – July Floods August 18th – 8th September – Level 4 lockdown

Reefton Swimming Pool – Reefton

Partial closure for 1 day in Feb while operating out of the Reefton Area School Pool – unplanned maintenance

Reefton Swimming Pool – Operated from the Reefton Area School Pool from January – March 2021 due to a facility upgrade (new building).
