											Opposes water and sewerage proposal - rushed nature and reliance on inaccurate QV/council data, believes it to be inequitable. Communication was confusing and crucial details missing. New policy will mean rates rise to 6720.40 from 4229.40, is unmanageable. Built unit for elderly mother under 90 m2 so as not to be considered as dwelling, and joined drains/sewerage onto existing dwelling at own cost to maintain one connection. Cannot be subdivided off or properly used as a rental, effectively an extension of main house/for family only. Should be a remission policy to address this instead of paying for two additional connections. User pays should guide charges and commercial properties be monitored and metered appropriately.
