## Refuse

Official Council rubbish bags are not accepted at the Karamea Landfill and Recycling Facility.

### Official charges

Minimum charge for refuse	\$12
Charge per tonne (above minimum) <i>(Includes green waste)</i>	\$132
Gas bottles <i>(Per item)</i>	\$22
Oil (used) <i>(Per litre)</i>	\$1.75
Domestic recycling <i>(Excludes cardboard and paper)</i>	Free of charge
Glass bottles and jars	Free of charge
Batteries	Free of charge
Scrap metal	Free of charge
Tyres <i>(Rims removed)</i>	Free of charge

## Recycling

Properly prepared recycling material can be dropped off for FREE at the Karamea Landfill and Recycling Centre.

### Materials accepted as recycling




Only clear **plastics #1, #2 and #5** are recyclable.



They need to be rinsed and clean with lids removed.



**Aluminium tins** and **steel cans** are recyclable. They need to be rinsed and clean.



**Scrap metal** including **car bodies** & **whiteware**.



**Household batteries** through Upcycle.



**Tyres** through TyreWise. Rims must be removed.

### Materials not accepted as recycling



**Cardboard** and **paper** are disposed of as refuse at the standard refuse charge.



**Glass bottles** and **jars** are disposed of as refuse FREE of charge.



**Green waste** is disposed of as refuse at the standard refuse charge.

**This facility accepts a range of other items, including properly prepared car bodies and scrap metal. Some items cannot be disposed of at this facility.**

If you are unsure whether your waste can be disposed of at this facility, please contact Site Manager for advice about alternative disposal options.
