Raising the bar for playground safety on the Coast



Late March saw Buller District Council's Property team host a two-day Playsafe playground equipment safety training session in our own back yard.

Playsafe, based in Auckland, is a global leader in playground safety, compliance, and risk management, with the mission "To elevate the safety, integrity, and enjoyment of play environments through certified inspection, expert advice and trusted

compliance".

Four WestReef staff, three external and two BDC Property team members attended the training, with everyone passing the written and practical exams with flying colours.

Wild West Coast weather on both days failed to dampen the crew's spirits as they headed out and about, gaining valuable insights and practical experience about confidently managing play spaces so they meet international standards.

Bullerview Map viewer

Did you know that Buller District Council has an updated public online map service, Bullerview, which has replaced the previous content for the Buller District Council's (WCRC) WestMaps viewer?

Bullerview contains up-to-date BDC data for drinking water, wastewater and stormwater assets, plus BDC's rates and property valuation information. Also included is the latest Land Information New Zealand (LINZ) property data such as parcel boundaries, legal descriptions and Certificate of Title information.

A round of new urban aerial imagery was co-funded by the Buller, Grey and Westland District Councils and the West Coast Regional Council in collaboration with LINZ in 2024 and this new imagery was used to update the service. New rural aerial imagery will be added to the map in the next few weeks.

A viewer guide is available within the map viewer itself, which shows users new to Bullerview the basic functions and tools available within the map.

Bullerview is free to use, and works on both desktop and mobile devices. The Bullerview Map Viewer can be accessed online [here](#).
