- 1. That one fee of \$200.00 (inclusive of GST) be paid per candidate per election.
- 2. That each candidate is restricted to a maximum of 12 hoardings in the Buller District, to include a maximum of four per ward (Seddon, Westport, Inangahua)
- 3. That the location of every hoarding shall be subject to landowner and Council approval, and that landowner approval shall be given in writing on the application form.
- That any hoarding that will be visible from the State Highway must also have the written approval of Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency before approval will be given by Council.
- 5. No hoarding shall be erected as to restrict or obstruct the visibility of traffic entering or exiting from any adjacent property.
- Any costs associated with enforcement, monitoring, storage and recovery of hoarding(s) shall be borne by the applicant.
