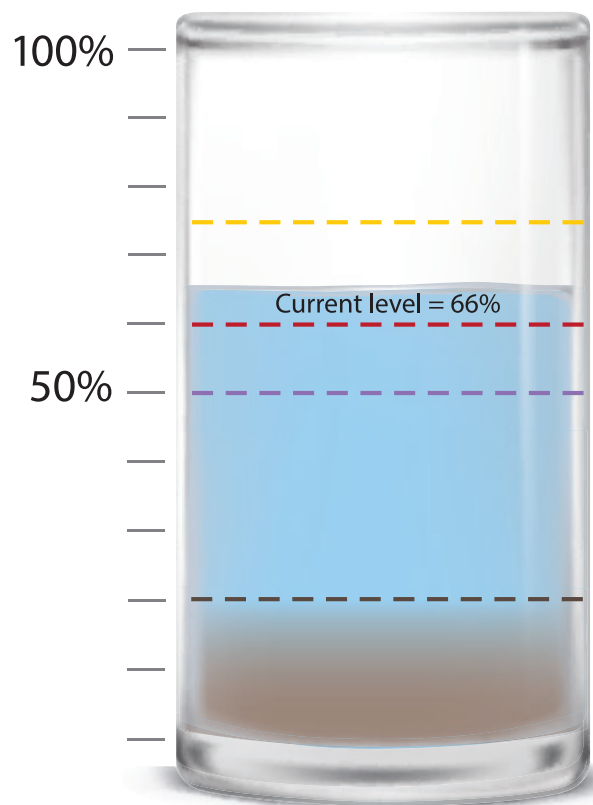


Westport/Carters Beach Water Supply

Daily Update – 4 March 2022

Today's reservoir level



Statistics

Current reservoir level = 66% (+5%)
Equivalent reserves = 10 days (+2 days)
Consumption = 4.98ML*/day (-0.43ML)
Supply (last 24 hrs) = 11.52ML (+3.47ML)

- The new level sensors that have been installed at the raw water ponds are now providing more accurate data for the 3 Waters team.
- Raw water turbidity at the main intake at Giles Creek has fallen sufficiently for flow to be reinstated to the raw water ponds. This is allowing significant recovery of raw water levels and the next few days of fine weather should see this continue.
- The water supply is still operating on Essential Use restrictions. This means that water can only be used for drinking, food preparation, hygiene and sanitary purposes only.

There is a complete ban on ALL outdoor water use.

*ML (megalitre) – 1000m³ (2.5ML equals the volume of an Olympic-sized swimming pool)
