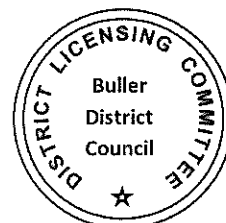

 - (iii) Transport options signage must be displayed. A phone must also be available on site to contact an alternative form of transport if required. A courtesy vehicle is also available.
- (e) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - (i) ID is to be requested from any person who looks under 25 years of age.
 - (ii) There must be no sale or supply of alcohol to minors or intoxicated persons and there must be displayed at every point of sale appropriate signs detailing these restrictions.
 - (iii) Any intoxicated persons may not enter or remain on the premises.
- (f) A copy of the licence and conditions must be displayed in a prominent place so as to be easily read by persons entering through the principal entrances.
- (g) The following parts of the premises are designated as:
Undesignated: Entire Premises. Any person of any age may be present on the premises. Those under 18 cannot be served alcohol, but may be supplied by their parent or legal guardian.
- (h) The manager appointed for the purpose of this licence is to be Rebekah Dickie (54/CERT/026/2021). A sign must be displayed identifying the duty manager.
- (i) A certified duty manager must be onsite during the event.
