6. Does your mayor/chair and/or chief executive have a council credit card? If so, what rules apply to its use?

Mayor does not have a credit card.

CEO has a credit card which is available for restricted use to pay for items. Expenses charged to a Council credit card are usually because Council doesn't have an account set up with the vendor and therefore it is not possible for the vendor to invoice Council for the amount. No personal expenses are included in the above amounts. Use of a credit card provides a clear trail of expenses incurred for audit purposes.

7. What was the number of FTE staff employed by your council at June 30, 2022?

- 83.5.

Last year was 74.4 FTEs so the increase seems significant. The additional staff numbers were employed in the flood recovery team. The cost of that team is funded by a variety of government funding support packages

8. What were your council's total staff costs for the year ended June 30, 2022?

- \$8,120,938

9. What percentage did staff costs comprise of your council's operating spending?

- \$8,121m/83.5 = \$97,257.

This \$ value is higher than in 2021 reflecting the individuals employed in the flood recovery team
