BDC's Response

The Brougham Street pedestrian plaza (including the stone-filled gabion baskets) is intended to remain established and be maintained by council to adequate standards of safety and amenity until the next stage of plaza development is reconsidered as part of the next LTP cycle for a decision by June 2025. Should there be any ongoing maintenance or repair work required in the interim, we encourage this to be reported to council through our service request system.
