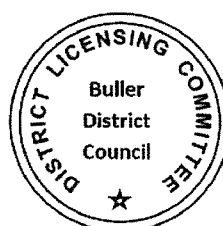
I therefore grant the application by Reefton Workingmens Club (the licensee) and authorise the issue of a special licence subject to the terms and conditions noted below as forming part of this decision.

Conditions to be imposed:

- (a) Alcohol may be sold or supplied only on the following days and hours:

Friday 19 December 2025	1.00pm until 10.00pm
Saturday 20 December 2025	6.30pm until 10.00pm
Wednesday 31 December 2025	6.00pm until 12.00am midnight
- (b) Free potable drinking water must be available on the premises for the duration of the licence.
- (c) Alcohol may be sold in the following types of containers only: Glasswear
- (d) The following steps must be taken to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol:
 - (i) Food must be available at reasonable prices for consumption for the duration of the event.
 - (ii) The licensee must have available for consumption, at all times when alcohol is being sold or supplied, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low alcohol refreshments.
 - (iii) Transport options signage must be displayed. A phone must also be available on site to contact an alternative form of transport if required. A courtesy vehicle is also available.
- (e) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - (i) ID is to be requested from any person who looks under 25 years of age.
 - (ii) There must be no sale or supply of alcohol to minors or intoxicated persons and there must be displayed at every point of sale appropriate signs detailing these restrictions.
 - (iii) Any intoxicated persons may not enter or remain on the premises.
- (f) A copy of the licence and conditions must be displayed in a prominent place so as to be easily read by persons entering through the principal entrances.
 The following parts of the premises are designated as:
Undesignated: Dining room, hallway and toilets. Any person of any age may be present on the premises. Those under 18 cannot be served alcohol, but may be supplied by their parent or legal guardian.
Supervised: Main bar lounge, billiards and bowling rooms. Persons under 18 may be present, but only if accompanied by a parent, or legal guardian, i.e. Court appointed. Those under 18 cannot be sold alcohol, but may be supplied by the parent or guardian.
Restricted: Smokers area. No person under 18 may be present in this area.
- (g) The managers appointed for the purpose of this licence are to be Stephanie Gilroy and Rachael Selwyn. A sign must be displayed identifying the duty manager.
- (h) A certified duty manager must be onsite during the event.
